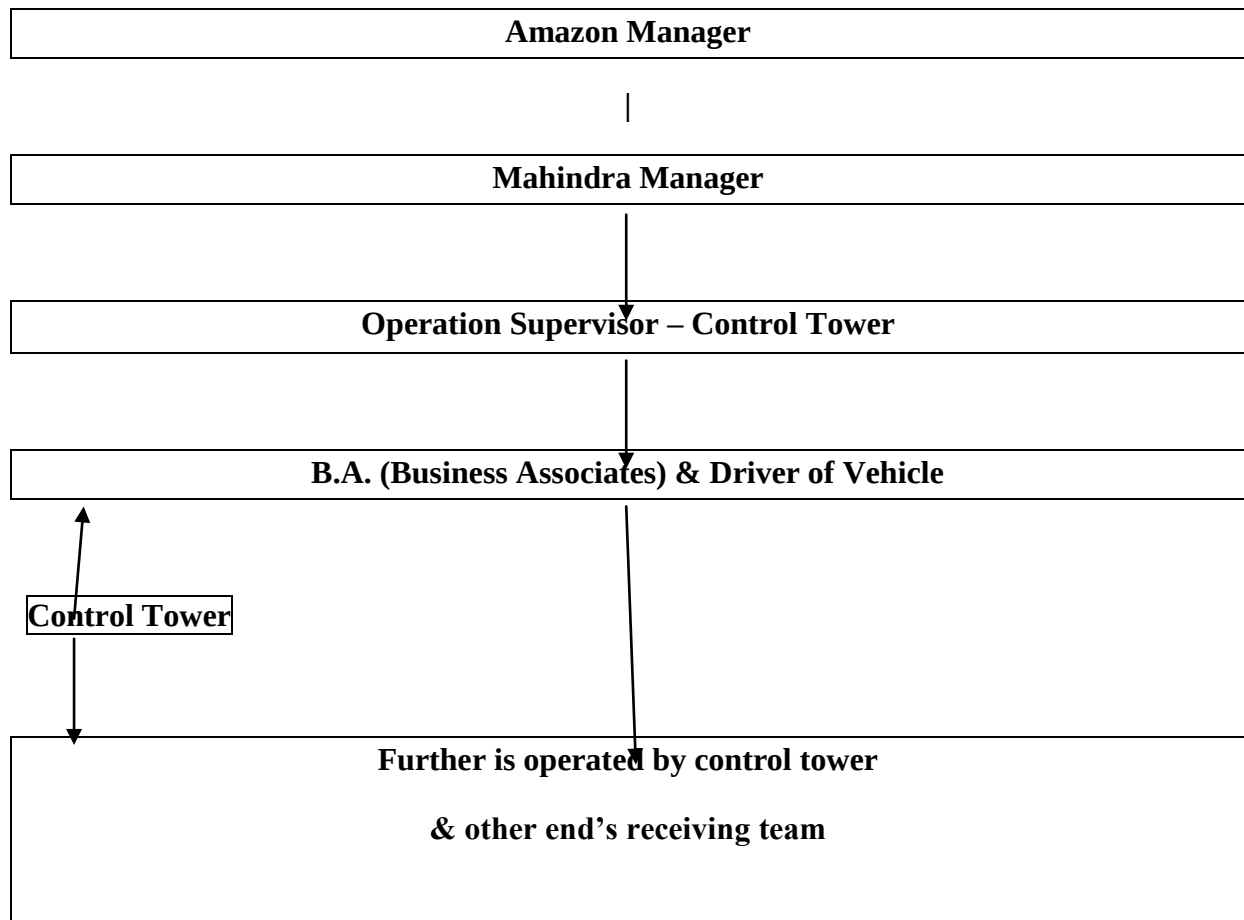
1.Introduction

The research design which was used for this research was a descriptive research design.

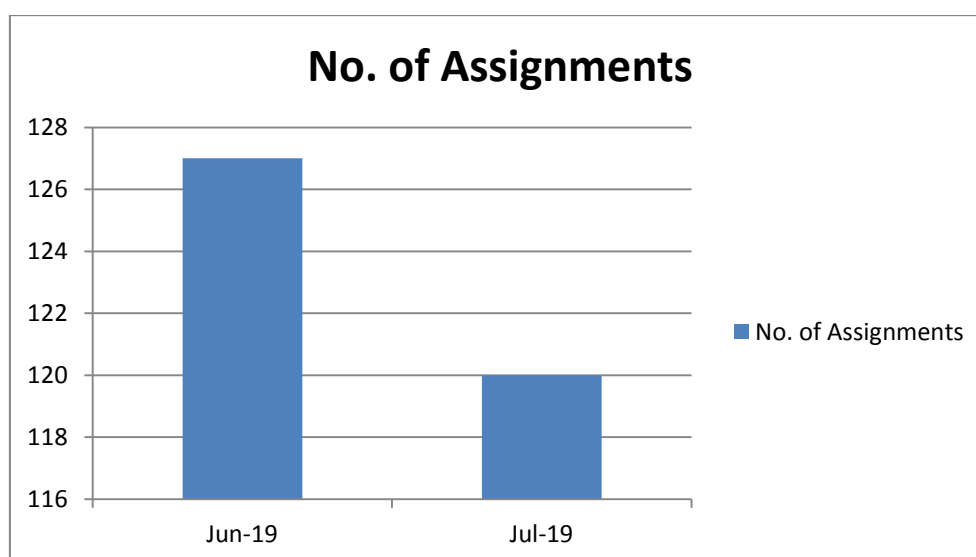
Information has to be gathered through discussion with Managers, Seniors Supervisors, Business associates & Drivers.

4.DATA ANALYSIS

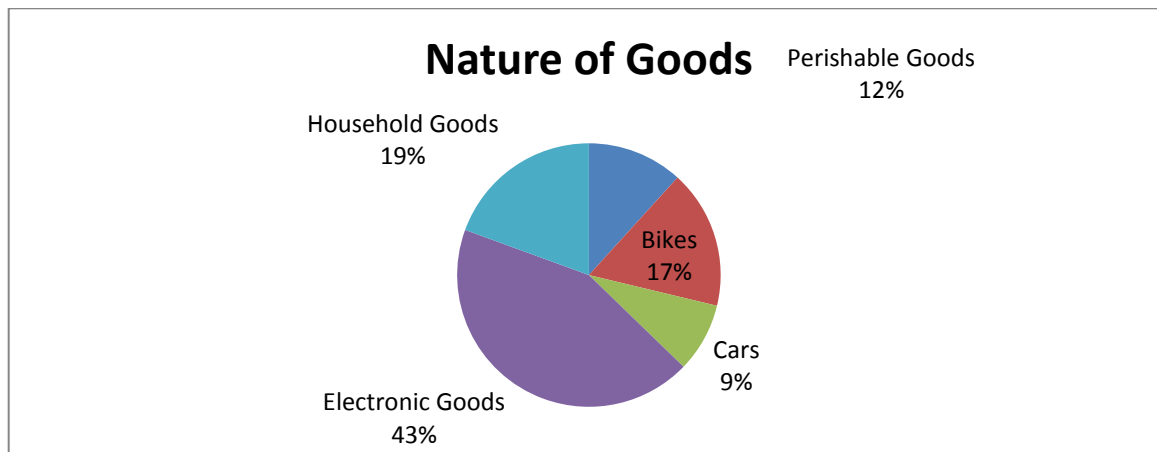
In my internship number of assignment that are vehicle trips are carried out during 01 June 2019 to 31 July 2019 are as follows;

No. of Assignments	29	42	21	107	48	247

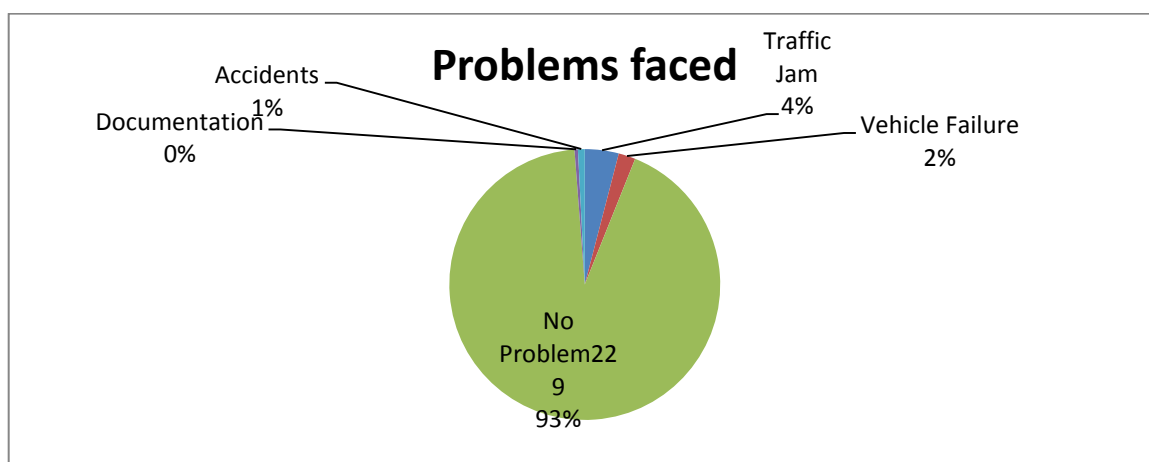


Interpretation:

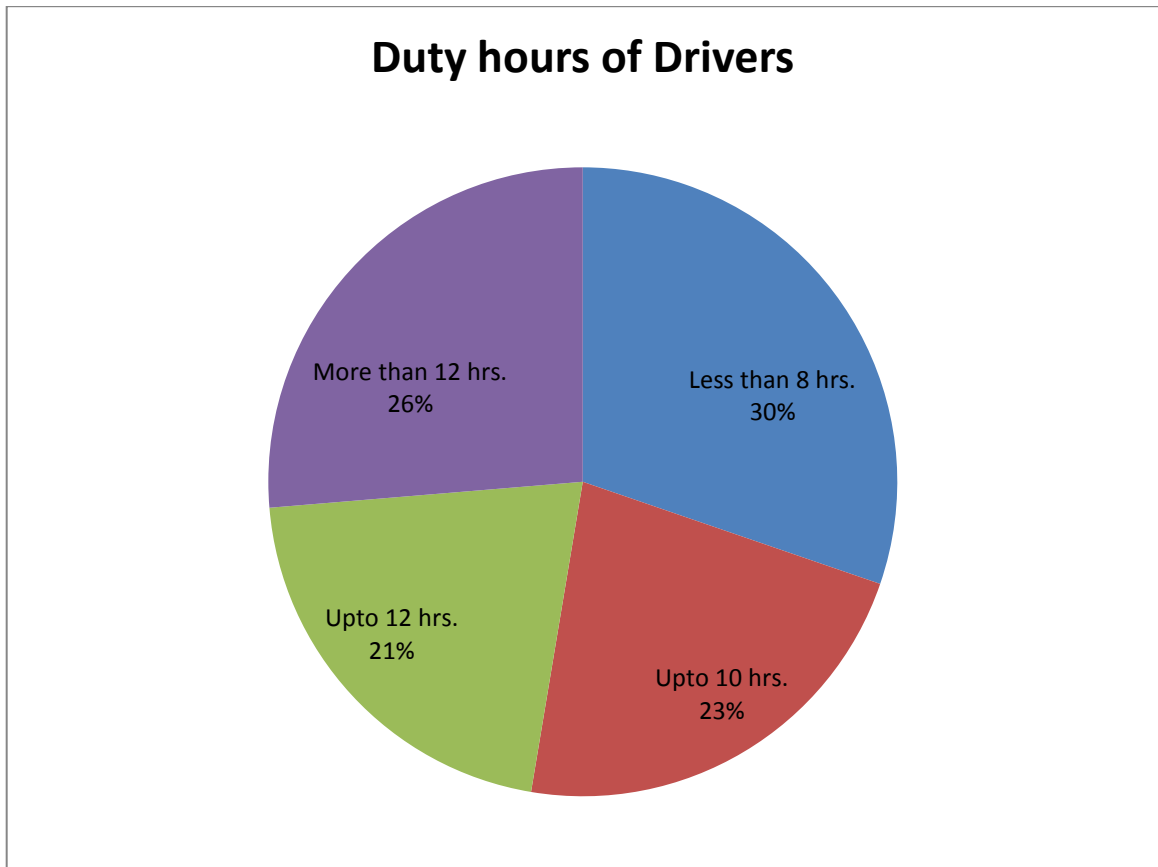


Interpretation:

What are duty hours to drivers ?

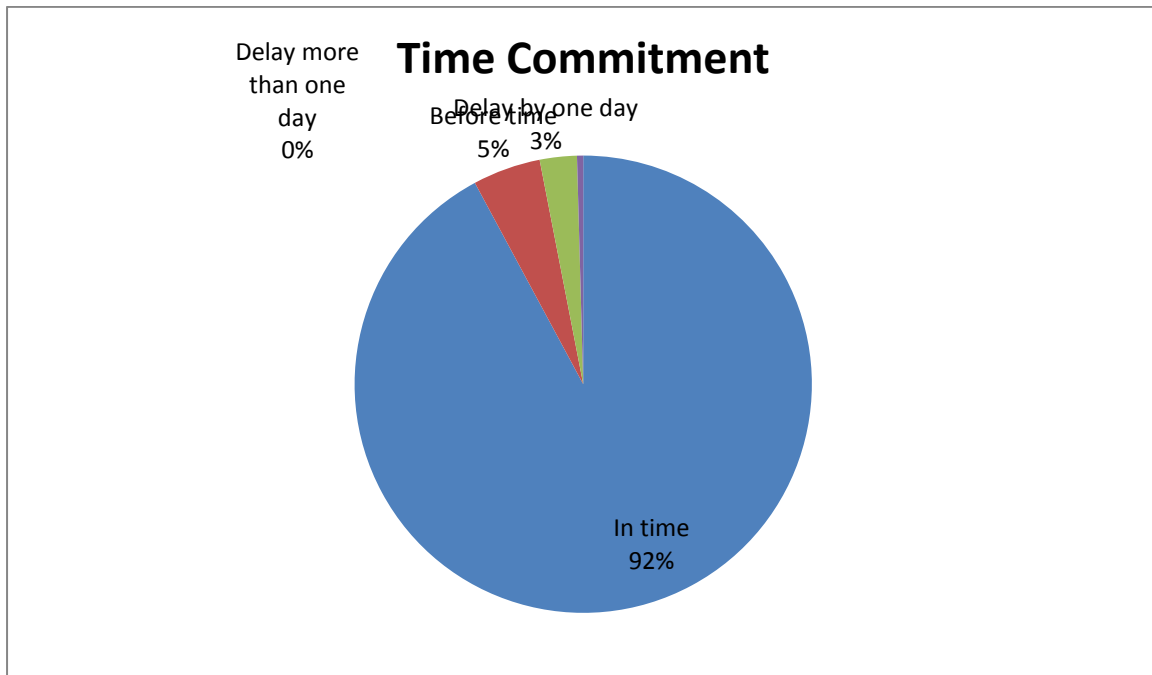

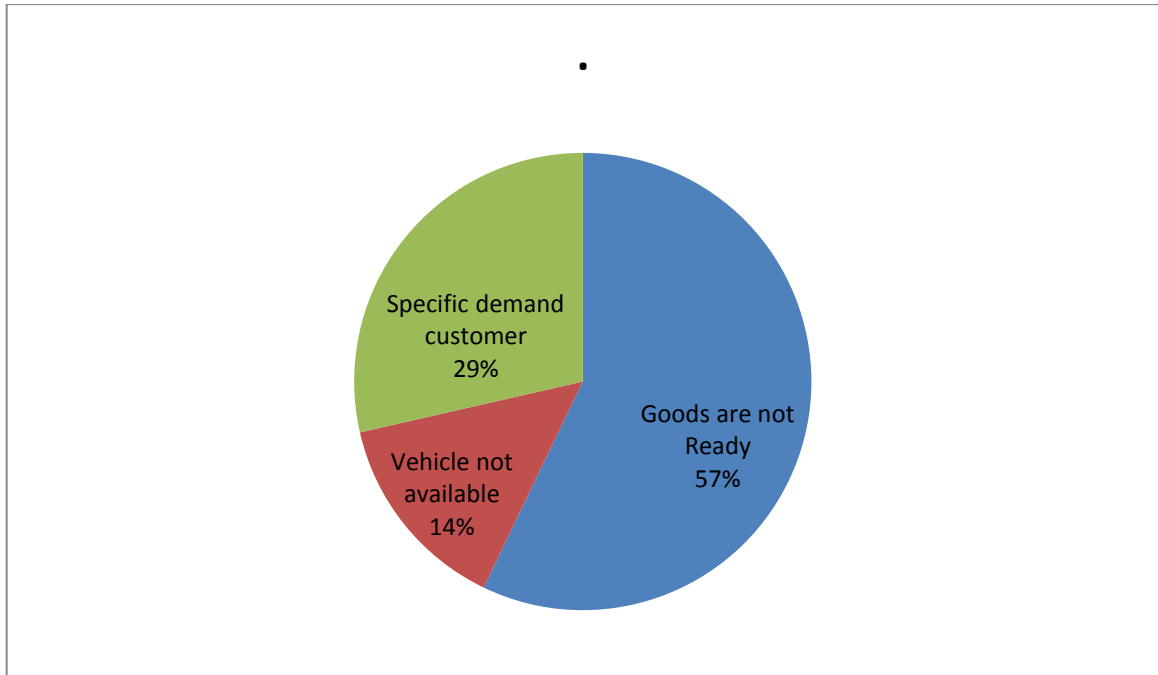


Interpretation:
