



Skill Development & Youth

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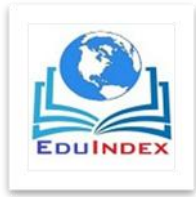
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Abstract

Student Complete their education in Three Stages which are given below -

1. Vasu- Those who had age upto 24 Year
2. Rudra-Those who had age upto 36 Year
3. Aaditya- Those who had age upto 48 Year

Students typically attended the Gurukul from age of 8 into their early twenties. In the above given period, student learn Vedic Literature, Vedic Grammar, Agriculture, Anthropology, Astronomy, Economics, Epistemology, Eschatology, Ethnology, Geology, Animal Husbandry, Mathematics & Military Sciences etc. Total 18 Subjects involve in Gurukul education system which start from the age of

On the behalf of Education student had full knowledge of Research things, Innovation techniques and presentation skills in them. Children were taught to live in the Gurukul with meager things and thus “Simple Living and High Thinking” was practiced.

Modern Education system exam and marks based. Present Era Education is not employment oriented. There is a vast gap between a general and vocational education system in India. Student Complete their education in Three Stages which are given below –

1. Lower Primary- for the age to 6 to 10 year (divided in 5 Standard)
2. Upper Primary- for the age to 11 to 12 year (divided in 2 Standard)
3. High School- for the age to 13 to 15 year (divided in 3 Standard)



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4. Higher Secondary- for the age to 17 to 18 year (divided in 2 Standard)
